Exposure	Part sun
Mature Size	14–20” H x 14–16” W
USDA Zones	8–11

- » A drought tolerant, semidwarf, and early blooming variety
- » Sturdy stems support interesting, almost black buds that open to dark purple flowers

HOW TO GROW FROM A LINER

MEDIA	Type	Perennial soil mix
	Soil / Bark	90% Fine screened bark plus 10% peat moss.
	Lime	Pulverized dolomitic, 5 lbs. per cubic yard
	Talstar	3.5 lbs. per cubic yard
	pH	5.5 – 6.5
	EC	2.0 – 3.0

FINISHING TIME	1 Gal	Plant 72 cell liner in the fall in greenhouse. Ready that spring
	2 Gal	Plant 72 cell liner in the spring. Ready that fall or next spring.
	3 Gal	Shift

SHIFTING UP	1 → 2 Gal	Shift in the fall in greenhouse. Sell that next spring.
	1 → 3 Gal	Shift in the fall in greenhouse. Sell that next spring.

FERTILIZER	Type	Top dress with slow release fertilizer
	App Rate	Medium
	Brands	Harrell's 18–5–13 OR Osmocote 15–9–11 OR Nutricote 18–6–8

CARE	Light	Part shade
	Growth Rate	Fast
	Water	Medium
	Trimming	No pruning needed

PROPAGATION

Timing	Divide spring to fall
Type	Tissue culture

Root Rate	Fast

Slugs and snails; Root diseases if too wet.
