KEY FEATURES

Exposure	Part shade
Mature Size	12-18" H x 12-18" W
USDA Zones	Hardy in USDA zones 5-9

- » A dramatic statement plant
- » Bright, colorful foliage, year round
- » Use as a groundcover, to edge a path or patio, or try tucking it into a living wall or window box

HOW TO GROW FROM A LINER

MEDIA	Type	Regular ornamental soil mix
	Soil / Bark	60% new screened bark plus 40% old screened bark.
	Lime	Pulverized dolomitic, 3.5 lbs per cubic yard
	Talstar	3.5 lbs per cubic yard
	pH	5.5 - 6.5
	EC	1.0 - 1.5

FINISHING TIME	1 Gal	Plant 72 cell liner in fall/winter (greenhouse). Finish 12-16 weeks. OR Plant 72 cell liner in spring (shade house). Finish for fall and spring.
	2 Gal	Plant 72 cell liner in spring (shade house). Finish for fall and spring.
	3 Gal	

SHIFTING UP	1 ↗ 2 Gal	Shift 1 gal. fall/winter (greenhouse). Finish 12-16 weeks
	1 ↗ 3 Gal	Shift 1 gal. fall/winter (greenhouse). Finish 16-18 weeks

FERTILIZER	Type	Top dress with slow release fertilizer
	App Rate	Medium
	Brands	Harrell's 18-5-13 or Osmocote 15-9-11 or Nutricote 18-8-8

CARE	Light	Part shade
	Growth Rate	Fast
	Water	Medium
	Trimming	No pruning needed

PROPAGATION

Timing	Spring or fall; avoid heat of the summer.
Type	Division
Hormone	IBA 1000 (optional)
Root Rate	Medium

PESTS & DISEASE	Aphids, fungal diseases if kept too wet or poor air circulation.
