HOW TO GROW FROM A LINER

MEDIA	Type	Perennial soil mix
	Soil / Bark	80% screened bark plus 10% crushed peat moss plus 10% perlite. Perennial Mix
	Lime	Pulverized dolomitic, 5 lbs per cubic yard
	Talstar	2.5 lbs per cubic yard
	pH	5.5 - 6.5
	EC	1.5 - 2.0

FINISHING TIME	1 Gal	Plant 72 cell liner in the fall in greenhouse. Ready that spring
	2 Gal	Plant 72 cell liner in the fall in greenhouse. Ready late spring
	3 Gal	Plant 72 cell liner in the early fall in greenhouse. Ready late spring

SHIFTING UP	1 ↗ 2 Gal	Shift in early fall in greenhouse. Sell that next spring.
	1 ↗ 3 Gal	Shift in early fall in greenhouse. Sell that next spring.

FERTILIZER	Type	Top dress with slow release fertilizer
	App Rate	Medium
	Brands	Harrell's 18-5-13 or Osmocote 15-9-11 or Nutricote 18-8-8

CARE	Light	Part shade
