HOW TO GROW FROM A LINER

MEDIA	Type	Regular ornamental soil mix
	Soil / Bark	60% new screened bark plus 40% old screened bark.
	Lime	Pulverized dolomitic, 5 lbs. per cubic yard
	Talstar	3.5 lbs. per cubic yard
	pH	5.5 – 6.5
	EC	1.5 – 2.0

FINISHING TIME	1 Gal	Plant 72 cell liner in the fall in greenhouse. Ready that spring
	2 Gal	Plant 72 cell liner in the fall in greenhouse. Ready that spring.
	3 Gal	Shift

SHIFTING UP	1 → 2 Gal	Shift in early fall in greenhouse. Sell that next spring.
	1 → 3 Gal	Shift in early fall in greenhouse. Sell that next spring.

FERTILIZER	Type	Top dress with slow release fertilizer
	App Rate	Medium
	Brands	Harrell’s 18–5–13 OR Osmocote 15–9–11 OR Nutricote 18–6–8

CARE	Light	Part shade
