KEY FEATURES

Exposure	Full sun to part shade
Mature Size	2.5–3.5' H x 2–3' W
USDA Zones	9–11

- » Incredibly tough plant
- » Unique variegated leaves, clumping habit, and pale yellow blooms
- » More sun = more blooms!

HOW TO GROW FROM A LINER

MEDIA	Type	Regular ornamental soil mix
	Soil / Bark	60% new screened bark plus 40% old screened bark.
	Lime	Pulverized dolomitic, 5 lbs per cubic yard
	Talstar	3.5 lbs per cubic yard
	pH	5.5 – 6.5
	EC	1.5 – 2.0

FINISHING TIME	1 Gal	Plant 72 cell liner in the fall in greenhouse. Ready late spring
	2 Gal	Plant 72 cell liner in the fall in greenhouse. Ready late spring after flush
	3 Gal	

SHIFTING UP	1 ↗ 2 Gal	Shift in the fall in greenhouse. Sell that next spring.
	1 ↗ 3 Gal	Shift in the fall in greenhouse. Sell late next spring.

FERTILIZER	Type	Top dress with slow release fertilizer
	App Rate	Medium
	Brands	Harrell's 18–5–13 or Osmocote 15–9–11 or Nutricote 18–8–8

CARE	Light	Full sun to part shade
	Growth Rate	Moderate
	Water	Low (drought tolerant)
	Trimming	None needed

Timing	Divide Spring to Fall/Tissue Culture
Type	Division/Tissue Culture
Hormone	No Dip Needed
Root Rate	Fast
