Hydrangea White Wedding®



KEY FEATURES	
Exposure	Full sun
Mature Size	4-6' H x 3-5' W
USDA Zones	Hardy in USDA zones 3-9

- » Sturdy, upright branches support large, pillow-like, white blooms
- » Compact, mounding habit, grows 5-6 feet tall
- » Use as a cut flower or in the garden from accent to mass planting

HOW TO GROW FROM A LINER

MEDIA	Type	Regular ornamental soil mix
	Soil / Bark	60% new screened bark plus 40% old screened bark.
	Lime	Pulverized dolomitic, 3.5 lbs per cubic yard
	Talstar	3.5 lbs per cubic yard
	pH	5.5 - 6.0
	EC	1.0 - 1.5

FINISHING TIME	1 Gal	Plant liner in early spring, finish that fall. OR Plant liner in July/August and it will finish with a spring flush.
	2 Gal	Plant liner in spring, finish that fall and following spring.
	3 Gal	Plant liner in early spring and it will finish with following spring flush.

SHIFTING UP	1 ↗ 2 Gal	Shift 1 gallon in fall / winter. Finish next spring with flush.
	1 ↗ 3 Gal	Shift 1 gallon in fall / winter. Finish next spring with flush.

FERTILIZER	Type	Top dress with slow release fertilizer
	App Rate	Medium
	Brands	Harrell's 18-5-13 or Osmocote 15-9-11 or Nutricote 18-8-8

CARE	Light	Full sun
	Growth Rate	Fast
	Water	Medium
	Trimming	Late winter, early spring, before flush. Dead-heading promotes new growth

PROPAGATION

Timing	Spring before bloom
Type	5-in soft to semi-hard tip cuttings
Hormone	None needed
Root Rate	Fast

PESTS & DISEASE	Aphids, spider mites, flea beetle
