HOW TO GROW FROM A LINER

MEDIA	Type	Perennial soil mix
	Soil / Bark	90% Fine screened bark plus 10% peat moss.
	Lime	Pulverized dolomitic, 5 lbs. per cubic yard
	Talstar	3.5 lbs. per cubic yard
	pH	5.5 – 6.5
	EC	1.5 – 2.0

FINISHING TIME	1 Gal	Plant 72 cell liner in fall/winter (greenhouse). Finish 12-16 weeks OR Plant 72 cell liner in spring (shade house). Finish for fall and spring.
	2 Gal	Plant 72 cell liner in the fall in greenhouse. Ready that spring after flush
	3 Gal	Plant 72 cell liner in the fall in greenhouse. Ready that spring after flush

SHIFTING UP	1 → 2 Gal	Shift 1 gal. fall/winter (greenhouse). Finish 12-16 weeks
	1 → 3 Gal	Shift 1 gal. fall/winter (greenhouse). Finish 16-18 weeks

FERTILIZER	Type	Top dress with slow release fertilizer
	App Rate	Medium
	Brands	Harrell's 18–5–13 OR Osmocote 15–9–11 OR Nutricote 18–6–8

CARE	Light	Full sun to part shade
	Growth Rate	Slow
	Water	Important. Not too wet!
	Trimming	No pruning needed

PROPAGATION

Timing	Spring or fall (not summer)
Type	Clump division with 4–6-in top; careful not to bruise bibs when dividing.
Hormone	IBA 1000
Root Rate	60–90 days / Medium–Slow
