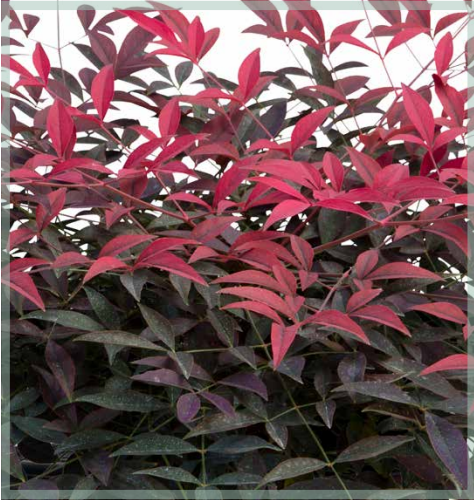

KEY FEATURES

Exposure	Part shade
Mature Size	1-2' H x 1.5-2' W
USDA Zones	Hardy in USDA zones 6-10

- » Stunning dark red growth; evergreen mature foliage
- » Reddens further in fall and winter
- » Dwarf growth habit

HOW TO GROW FROM A LINER

MEDIA	Type	Regular ornamental soil mix
	Soil / Bark	60% new screened bark plus 40% old screened bark.
	Lime	Pulverized dolomitic, 3.5 lbs per cubic yard
	Talstar	3.5 lbs per cubic yard
	pH	5.5 - 6.5
	EC	2.0 - 3.0

FERTILIZER	Type	Top dress with slow release fertilizer
	App Rate	Medium
	Brands	Harrell's 18-5-13 or Osmocote 15-9-11 or Nutricote 18-8-8

CARE	Light	Part shade
	Growth Rate	Medium
	Water	Medium
	Trimming	No pruning needed

FINISHING TIME	1 Gal	TC liners result in healthy uniform crops. Plant 72 cell liner in the fall in greenhouse. Ready that spring. OR Plant 72 cell liner in the spring. Ready that fall or next spring. Can use for shift.

SHIFTING UP	1 ↗ 2 Gal	Shift 1 gal in the fall in greenhouse. Sell that next spring.
	1 ↗ 3 Gal	Shift 1 gal in the fall in greenhouse. Sell that next spring.

PESTS & DISEASE	White fly, aphids ,spider mites, thrips, cercospora leaf spot, rhizoctonia web blight, xanthomonas spp. Bacteria and root rot if kept too wet.
