## STUDENT POSTER SUBMISSION AND SCHOLARSHIP OPPORTUNITIES

Thursday–Saturday, November 8–10th, 2018

The 2018 Independent Plant Breeders Conference is right around the corner and the Student Scholarship and Poster Submission Committee is soliciting applications.

### POSTER SUBMISSION

Posters should illustrate student's research in an area that will advance the science of plant breeding. Posters will be accepted based on space requirements and adherence to the topic. Applied or theoretical submissions will be considered.

There is no formal application form. Please submit the following via email:

- Poster Title
- Description of the topic and how the topic applies to the criteria (maximum 250 words)
- Poster size not to exceed 36" wide x 42" high

Accepted poster will qualify the student for complimentary conference registration.

### STUDENT TRAVEL SCHOLARSHIPS

We have a limited amount of funds to provide travel and accommodation reimbursement (up to \$500 per student). Students may apply by submitting a written essay describing their interest in plant breeding or related plant sciences and how attending this conference would further their educational and career objectives. Essays should be no more than 1,500 words and submitted via email. The judging committee will review all submissions.

Submissions should be emailed by 5:00pm CT Wednesday, October 24th, 2018. Students will be notified via email not later than Wednesday, October 31st, 2018. Please include:
